

Dry Cell/ Rechargeable Batteries

Alkaline, Ni-Cd, Ni-Mh, Ni-Zn



- Tape the terminals of all batteries 9V or higher.
- Never include any batteries with liquid electrolyte or wet cell chemistries.

Wet cell/ Gel Cell/ Steel Cased/ Rechargeable Batteries

Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb)



- DOT requires battery terminals to be taped.
- Stack units along the floor of EWASTE+ bin, pallet, or bucket. Place cardboard between each layer. (Three layers max.)

Lithium Batteries

Lithium Ion, Lithium Button Cell, Laptop Rechargeable



- The DOT requires ALL lithium battery terminals to be taped.
- Do not combine with other non-Lithium batteries.

Please Note:

- Materials deemed unacceptable that are placed inside universal waste containers will be subject to additional handling fees due to the terms and conditions.
- Multiple battery buckets should be placed in an EWASTE+ bin for transport.
- Damaged, leaking or swollen batteries are not accepted.
- Please use clear tape when taping battery terminals to allow EWASTE+ to confirm the battery chemistry.



Please shrink wrap the first layer when organizing lead acid batteries on a pallet.

Fluorescent & LED Lamps (4' & 8')

Lamps & Bulbs



- Please store in original packaging or an EWASTE+ lamp box.
- Large quantities may elect to use premium packaging for an additional fee. Contact your Client Services Rep.
- Boxes must be kept closed and taped to reduce breakage.
- Please label all boxes appropriately with provided Universal Waste Label. (Identify contents as “Used Lamps”, and include accumulation start date.)

- Please store in original packaging, or an EWASTE+ cardboard box.
- Boxes must be kept closed and taped to reduce breakage.
- High intensity bulbs (HIDS) must be packaged in their original packaging or wrapped in paper.
- Due to compliance standards, EWASTE+ is not able to pick up lamps that protrude from its packaging, or that have been visibly overcrowded.



*Please keep all bulbs and lamps intact.
Broken bulbs or lamps are subject to additional handling requirements and fees.*
